I. Call to order

Jill called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

II. Approval of minutes from Oct 17 meeting

Tara moved to approve the minutes. Lyn seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

III. Business and Finance

A. Oct Treasurer's Report

ABC started the month with a balance of \$24,050.43. Withdrawals equaled \$345 for an ending balance of \$23,705.43.

Jill moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Tara seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

B. 2022-2023 Budget Overview

The group looked over the annual budget.

IV. Programs

A. Staff Club

Jill heard from Stephanie Bobman that Ben Jewell was the winner of the October raffle. Staff club is combining November and December into one raffle. Ms. Bobman requested gift certificates to gift stores. Jill has purchased a \$25 gift card to Chocolate Soup and will purchase another \$25 card to Mae It Be Home this week.

B. Special Harvard presentation Nov 8 results

Sixty-three students signed up for the Harvard presentation. Sixty of those students attended, plus another handful who showed up at the door. Harvard Alumni Representatives Dave Ardell and Douglas Van Sant share information with students and answered questions. Collette knows of at least one student who is going to be applying to Harvard as a result of the presentation. Overall, the event was a success.

C. Potential college round table in future years

Jill spoke with Counselor Flora Savage and Collette after the presentation and heard from Flora that in future years, she would like to expand this both by providing representatives from a variety of types of higher ed schools in a round table discussion with students and by doing this during a class period rather than during lunch time so that students have an hour and a half for it rather than the short lunch period. She said that if planning for it starts early enough in the school year, the high school can make this work. This is something to put on the agenda of next school year's planning meeting.

Unfortunately, this date conflicts with a big FFA field trip so there will be less students attending. The most recent count was 22.

Collette spoke with Counselors who suggested MCHS alumni and entrepreneurs. They also suggested someone from Tavis.

Tara let us know that CalFire is scheduled for December 8. They are sending two fire trucks and younger firefighters will be the presenters. This will happen outside the Fire class room.

Tara has Andy Carter scheduled for Jan. He is an MCHS grad and works for Mariposa County Health and Human Services, coordinating a lot of work around the Oak Fire Recovery.

For February, Tara has reached out to a couple in the biomedical field. She was also thinking of Zach from Sticks to fit the entrepreneur request.

Tara will check with Tavis. She also heard of interest in kinesiology and plans to talk with either Jeremiah Berry who is a physical therapist (and former MCHS football store) or, if he is unavailable, with the PT on the corner of 12th and Bullion.

Collette mentioned that teacher Nathan Savig's wife is the Director of Hiring for Yosemite National Park. Nathan said she is interested in speaking. Collette will pass along her info to Tara.

E. Season of Giving
